The Central Bank of The Bahamas warmly invites all Bahamian Junior and Senior High School students to participate in the 41st Annual High School Art Competition. For over four decades, this competition has been a cornerstone in our commitment to nurturing and showcasing young Bahamians who demonstrate talent in the creative fields.

For this year's competition there are no theme, medium or size restrictions.

While you are limitless in what you choose to submit, here are the requirements:

- 1. The work you submit must have been created within the past year.
- 2. Non-digital entries, whether paintings, sculptures, drawings, objects, etc. must be photographed from different angles in high resolution (300 dpi).
- 3. You must submit a short video clip (max. 90 sec.) that tells us about yourself and the work that you are submitting.
- 4. Only 1 submission is allowed (instead of 3 submissions in the previous competitions). However, you are allowed to add any images or text that will help us further understand your submission.

Non-digital and digital artwork (photographs, film, new media, etc.) as well as audio files can be uploaded directly to the Submittable platform following the link on our website. The submission link can be found here: <u>www.artcentralbankbahamas.com/high-school</u>.

A panel of judges will select winning entries for the following:

- 1. Overall First Award \$2,000
- 2. Overall Second Award \$1,800
- 3. Senior High First Award \$1,500
- 4. Senior High Second Award \$1,000
- 5. Junior High First Award \$800
- 6. Junior High Second Award \$600
- 7. Governor's Choice Award \$2,500

The deadline for all submissions is Friday, November 29, 2024. By then, your submission must be uploaded as digital files (JPG, MP3, MP4) to the Submittable platform.
